I. ELECTIONS FOR PRESIDENTIAL TICKETS AND CONGRESSIONAL REPRESENTATIVES

Pursuant to R.B. § 3-5-7(a)(1), please note these results are preliminary and are subject to change. Only the Court's Certification is final pending the adjudication of election violation complaints.

These results have been released pursuant to the provisions of R.B. § 3-5-7. Results are arranged by alphabetical order. The names of candidates are arranged in order of vote percentage and those who have been elected are shown in **green**.

Each vote percentage shown here is out of the total number of votes cast in that question, **not** the total number of ballots cast. Each voter was only permitted to cast one ballot but was allowed to mark votes for multiple candidates in each question in which they were eligible to vote. As a result, the percentages shown here are less than the percentage of voters who supported each respective candidate.
